Dear participants

For the organisation of the Mondraker Enduro Team we have drawn up a catalogue of measures based on the requirements of the "Bundesamt für Gesundheit" (BAG) (Federal Office of Public Health) in order to guarantee the safety and health of all participants in our event in the best possible way.

The currently valid requirements of the Federal Council for events apply:

REQUIREMENTS

Only those who can show a valid Covid certificate with QR code are admitted to the event. This means who has been tested, recovered or vaccinated.

Important:

- The vaccine must be recognized in Switzerland. Ask your own health office (family doctor/vaccination centre).
- The vaccination must be fully completed.
- Have the QR code/certificate (also possible in paper form) ready at the entrance control with your ID.
- Persons with a non-valid certificate will not be admitted. You can be tested directly at our registration office on site.

ON-SITE TEST CENTRE

If you do not have a Covid certificate, you can book an appointment directly on site. The test centre is located directly at the registration desk. [Online registration](#) for testing on site is mandatory. It takes about 15 minutes to get a result and a valid Covid certificate. The test is free of charge.

COVID CERTIFICATE

It's best to download the "COVID Certificate" app right away so you can carry your certificate electronically, which is provided in paper form or as a PDF document with a QR code.

Switzerland's Covid certificate is compatible with that of the EU; they are mutually recognized. The EU COVID certificate is recognized as a valid COVID certificate for the 2021 Enduro Team.

HEALTH

We count on your solidarity! If you feel ill, please stay at home and let us know. If you feel symptoms, report to the OC (+41 76 414 75 45) immediately.

REGISTRATION

Registration and distribution of start numbers will take place at Chalet After7 on the car park of the Jakobshornbahn in Davos Platz.

Wednesday 17:00 – 19:30

Thursday 08:00 – 11:00

Masks are compulsory inside the start number collection area. The distance must be observed wherever possible.

The following must be presented / handed in at the registration:

- valid Covid certificate with ID

- signed disclaimer

With a valid Covid certificate you will receive a wristband which must be worn throughout the event. This will also allow you to enter the Enduro Team Night.

The contact details of all participants will be checked again for correctness during registration. In addition, all participants will be registered as to where they will be staying on site.

BRIEFING

The briefing for each race day will take place online. From 7.00 p.m. the briefing can be downloaded from [enduro-team.ch](https://enduro-team.ch/en/programm/) under the programm for the respective day. <https://enduro-team.ch/en/programm/>

START AND FINISH BOLGEN

The minimum distance of 1.5 metres and the general hygiene regulations apply in all event areas. The start/finish area will be spacious and open-air. Mouth-nose protection (MNS) is not compulsory here.

The starting field will be limited to a maximum of 450 participants. There will be two large starting areas from which the participants can move to the next one. The starting blocks in the morning will consist of 40 participants. A starting block will start every 15 minutes.

RACE COURSES / TRANSFER COURSES / START AND FINISH STAGES

On the race and transfer tracks, masks are not compulsory, participants are reminded of the general distance rule. The tracks are outside and the bike automatically gives a certain distance, which always exceeds 1.5 metres.

On the transfer routes, the mountain railways will be used in part. In the indoor areas, masks are compulsory for all in accordance with the regulations of the government.

The start and finish areas of the individual stages will be approached by the participants at intervals. The start and finish areas are located outside and are generously laid out so that keeping the distance is not a problem.

LUNCH FOR PARTICIPANTS

On Friday and Saturday the participants will eat in a restaurant on the course. On Thursday, the choice of restaurant will be made individually. In the catering establishments, the protection concept of the respective operator will apply.

In indoor areas, as before, seating is compulsory during consumption, and the distance between groups must be maintained. Contact details must still be collected, but one contact per group is sufficient. The mask must also continue to be worn, except when guests are seated at the table.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Showers and cloakrooms are not available.

Dispensers with disinfectant are available at the start number distribution and in the start and finish area

REPAIR POST

The repair post is outside and therefore masks are not required unless the distance cannot be maintained.

SIDE EVENTS

The award ceremony will take place outside in the start-finish area on Saturday after the race. Masks are not compulsory.

Conditions permitting, the Mondraker Enduro Team Night will take place on Saturday evening in the Bolgen Plaza. As access is only possible with a Covid certificate, masks are not compulsory. However, masks may of course be worn if this is a requirement for your own safety.
